The island is known for its pristine white beaches, sparkling blue waters and tropical climate with unique flora and fauna. The official language is Dutch but English and Spanish are spoken widely. Papiamentu, however, is the most widely spoken language and is a mixture of African languages, Spanish, Dutch, French, Portuguese, English and Arawak. Curaçao's laid back lifestyle presents the perfect opportunity to slow down, relax and recharge.
